LEOTARD CARE

To Realize her leotards Sigoa uses only high quality fabrics which need a proper care and maintenance to keep all the features in the best way for long time.

To keep your leotards perfect as long as possible follow these few steps:

- Wash your leotard only hand wash
- Always wash your leotards on reverse

- Use protective nets for washing machines
- Do not leave the leotards in the water
- Do not use bleaches, stain removers or softeners
- Wash at maximum 30 degrees and rinse the leotard immediately
- Do not wash more than one leotard at a time
- Dab water excess with a towel
- Do not hang out the leotard horizontally but put in on a crutch
- Do not dry leotard using heat sources such as: heater, phone or dryer
- Do not iron or vaporise
- Do not leave the leotard folded wet or sweaty
- Do not use deodorants

Modern detergents also the most delicate ones often contain aggressive substances as bleaches and softeners, for this reason we advice you to use only solid soap for laundry or flake soap. Sigoa won't be responsable in case of washing its leotards with different no recommended soaps.

LEOTARDS WITH METALLIC FABRICS

Leotards made with metallic, hologram or lurex fabrics can damage because of frequent washing. The part more subjected to rubbing or more in contact with sweat or deodorant can wear out, discolour or show some shine. If you want to keep it well as long as possible we advice you not to use it frequently for training.

TULLE

Leotards assembled with tule are very delicate and are subject to wear both in training and in competition.

LEOTARDS WITH CONTRAST COLORS

All leotards that present a strong contrast of color for example: dark colors in combination with particularly light colors have to be washed only in a great quantity of water to avoid contamination of colors.

RHINESTONES

Despite we apply Rhinestones with high technical performance machineries, frequent washings, rubbings and usury can sometimes cause detachment.

By law do not exist a guarantee on duration of the rhinestones.
